



By foot from Chester University Campus

Exit the campus via Exton Park. Turn right and follow the road until the Northgate (Fountains) roundabout subway. Take the Northgate Street exit and continue straight on to the City Centre. At the Cross, carry on down Bridge Street and straight on at the traffic lights. Continue down Lower Bridge Street and turn right onto Castle Drive.

By Car

From the Campus/ North (A540, A5116)

- Approaching Chester City Centre via the A5116 or A540 or Depart main campus via Exton Park, turn right onto Parkgate Road A540, continue ahead at lights
- At 2nd traffic lights take right hand lane, turn right onto Liverpool Road A5116
- At the roundabout, take the third exit to St Martins Way A5268
- At the roundabout, take the third exit to Grosvenor Rd A483 for 27m
- Turn left onto Castle Drive - Pay and Display Car Park Parking is 15m on the right
- Walk along Castle Drive. The entrance to Riverside is 50m on the left.

From the east (A51, A55, A56, M53, M6)

- From the east (A51, A55, A56, M53, M6)
- Approach Chester City Centre via the A56 (Hoole Rd), over Hoole Bridge (the railway station on the left)

- At the next roundabout take the 1st exit into the A5268 St. Oswald's Way
- At the Bars roundabout take the third exit onto the A5268.
- Keep in the left hand lane and continue on the A5268
- At the roundabout, take the second exit to Grosvenor Road A483 for 27m
- Turn left onto Castle Drive - Pay and Display Car Park Parking is 15m on the right
- Walk along Castle Drive. The entrance to Riverside is 50m on the left.

From the south & west (A5, A55, A483, A41)

- Approaching Chester City Centre via the A483, over the Grosvenor Bridge
- At the roundabout by the castle, take the 4th exit and stay on Grosvenor Road/A483
- Turn left onto Castle Drive - Pay and Display Car Park Parking is 15m on the right
- Walk along Castle Drive. The entrance to Riverside is 50m on the left.

By Rail

Chester is well served by the railway network and has frequent, fast rail links to London and major cities in the UK. Journey times are: London 2hrs 40mins, Birmingham 1hr 45mins, Manchester 1hr. A taxi will cost approximately £4. A free bus service runs at regular intervals between the Railway Station and Chester City Centre.
